LIABILITY WAIVER FORM

Therefore, in return for the privilege of participating in the Grinch Fest Festival, I hereby give this, my unconditional waiver of liability and hold harmless agreement, to and in favor of the Lake Whitney Chamber of Commerce, together with all of its organizers, officers, directors and staff.
By this act, I agree forever to release the Lake Whitney Chamber of Commerce and all its organizers, officers, directors and staff from any and all liability for any injury or harm I or any members of said organization including any minor child may suffer as a result of participation in said parade or activities preparatory or subsequent thereto. This act shall bind me, as well as my heirs, family and assigns.

Grinch-Fest PARADE RULES:

- 1. Bring Canned foods for the Whitney Food Bank (See List on back Page)
- 2. A signed Release and Hold Harmless Agreement must be signed.
- 3. No registrations will be accepted after 4:00 p.m. on December 10th, 4 pm
- 4. No alcoholic beverages are permitted. No vulgarity will be permitted. Participants and entries in the parade are not allowed to have or be under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- 5. Tow and trailer length not to exceed 35 feet without written permission from parade officials.

- 6. When throwing candy no damaging materials, projectiles or profane materials will be permitted.
- 7. It is required that a minimum of two walkers, one on either side must accompany each entry during the entire parade route as protection for your group and vehicle/float, and to prevent injury to people lining the streets. The kids running out in front of vehicles to get candy almost caused an accident last year.
- 8. Parade entries are expected to arrive for line up at the Intermediate School parking lot beginning at 5 p.m.
- 9. The parade will leave the school at 6 p.m.
- 10. We estimate that the entire parade route will take approximately one hour.
- 11. The Parade Chair will place you in the order the committee has agreed upon, which all entries must abide by.
- 12. Parade Coordinators reserve the right to remove your entry from this parade for not abiding by the rules outlined above.
