

The entry date to pick up applications is June 1, 2025. Application and entry fee deadline to return to the Chamber office is September 1st by 4:00 P.M. Any late entry forms will not be accepted and contestant will not be eligible to be included in the pageant.

All guest will be expected to purchase a ticket for the pageant. This will exclude the contestants and the helper/parent for minors.

Outfits for Competitions

- ❖ Interview you will be required to wear Business Casual 0 40% of your score (Business Casual Wear- 15% Interview- 25%)
- Western Wear- you will be required to wear western attire 0
 25% of your score
- Evening dress- you will be required to wear a format dress of your choosing. (cocktail, tea-length or long are acceptable)

0 35% of your score

You will be expected to behave at all times, be respectful of the adults in charge of the pageant and courteous to all other contestants. All participants will be expected to be on time for every session.

You are responsible for bringing all your own personal products (blow dryers, curling irons etc.) 'Lil Miss and Jr. Miss participants will be allowed <u>one person</u> to assist during changing sessions. If there becomes a problem back stage, helpers will be asked to join the audience.

All participants will receive gift bags.

- Second runner-ups will receive a trophy
- First runner-ups will receive a ribbon and flowers
- Winning contestants will receive sashes, flowers, tiaras and trophies

Photos will be taken of the winners for each category by our photographer. Our photographer will also be taking photos during and leading up to the event. Photos will be made available to purchase. Outside photographs or video are permitted however we ask that you not interfere will the official photographer.

Any sponsors obtained to pay the entry fee will be announced on stage during the pageant.

Obligations and Duties

The Lake Whitney Chamber of Commerce will use winner photographs throughout the year as Chamber of Commerce promotions. Winners will be expected to participate in neighboring cities parades (will have advanced notice) and will be asked to attend Chamber functions (ribbon cutting ceremonies etc.) during 2023 reign. Winners will need to conduct exemplary behavior at all times as an ambassador for the City of Whitney and the Lake Whitney Chamber of Commerce.

Crowned winners will reign until the 2024 pageant is over and the successor has been crowned. If for any reason they cannot fulfill their duties the first runner-up will ascend to wear the crown. In the event the first runner-up cannot fulfill their obligation the second runner-up will take over for the remainder of the reign.

If you have won a crown in any of these categories you will not be eligible to compete again in that category. You must wait until you have reached the age to enter the next category up.

- The second runner-up in the Miss, Jr. Miss and 'Lil Miss will receive a trophy.
- The first runner-up in the Miss, Jr. Miss and 'Lil Miss will receive a ribbon, flowers.
- The Miss, Jr. Miss and 'Lil Miss winners will receive sashes, flowers, tiaras, trophies.
- Photos will be taken of the 3 winners in each category along with pictures from the entire day by our photographer.
- You may obtain sponsors to pay the entry fee and they will be included in the program and announced on stage during the pageant.

Winners Obligations and Duties:

- We will use your pictures in promotions throughout the year and for any other Chamber of Commerce promotions.
- The winners will be expected to participate in neighboring cities parades, with as much notice
 as possible, and the winners will at times be asked to attend Chamber functions such as Ribbon
 cutting ceremonies or events held during the year of the reign.

INFORMATION / RULES

Submit contestant information with your entry form. Contestant information will be read at the pageant during the evening attire. We reserve the right to edit the information.

You must be a resident or a student in Hill or Bosque County to qualify.

- 'Lil Miss category age is 5 to 9 only, no exceptions, and you must be 5 to 9 by the date of the pageant.
- Jr. Miss category age is 10 to 14 only, no exceptions, and you must be 10 to 14 by the date of the pageant.
- Miss category age is 15 to 19 only, no exceptions, and you must be 15 to 19 by the date of the
 pageant.

The entry date to pick up applications is June 1, 2025 and the deadline to turn them back into the Chamber offices is **September 1**st by 4:00 p.m. Any entry forms after that day will not be eligible to be included in the pageant. All entry fees must be paid by **September 1st** or you won't be eligible to be included in the pageant.

All guests will be expected to purchase a ticket for the pageant excluding the contestants and one helper/parent.

Outfits for Competitions

- Interview with Judges You will be required to wear Business/Casual or Sunday best.
 Total 45% of your score. (Interview-30% ~ Business/Casual Wear-15%)
- Western Wear 20% of your score.
- Evening dress 35% of your score. You need to wear after five, short, tea-length or long, formal dress of your choosing.

You will be expected to behave at all times, be respectful of the adults in charge of the pageant and courteous to all the contestants.

You will be responsible for bringing all your personal products (blow dryers, curling irons, etc.) and will be allowed **one person** to assist only the <u>Jr. Miss and 'Lil Miss contestants</u> during the changing sessions.

The Miss contestants will not be allowed assistants.

If there becomes a problem back stage then those helpers will be asked to join the others in the audience as there will be lots of people, noise and confusion and we want the pageant to run as smoothly as possible so all of us can enjoy this annual event.
